The petitioner prays for transfer of petition HMA/DMC No. 566/16 of 16.08.2016 titled 'Yogesh Kumar vs. Smt. Shalu' from the Court of District Judge (Family Court) Sonapat to a Court of competent jurisdiction at Kaithal.

Counsel for the parties are ad idem that all litigations between the parties filed either at the instance of the applicant or on behalf of the respondent may be transferred to a Court of competent jurisdiction at Kaithal. It is further agreed that in future, any litigation arising out of marital disharmony to be filed by either of the parties against the other shall also be instituted at Kaithal.

In view of the above, the aforesaid petition filed by the respondent-husband is withdrawn from the Court of District Judge (Family

Court) Sonapat and transferred to the Court of District Judge, Kaithal for proceeding with the case, in accordance with law. The litigation filed by the applicant-wife and pending in the Court at Guhla, Kaithal also stands transferred to the Court of Chief Judicial Magistrate, Kaithal. In future, any litigation between the parties, arising out of marital disharmony would be filed by either of them against the other in a Court of competent jurisdiction at Kaithal.

Disposed of accordingly.
