Prayer in this application is for transfer of petition titled 'Gaurav Arora Vs. Smt. Shakshi' from the Court at Hisar to a Court of competent jurisdiction at Sirsa.

Counsel for the applicant has submitted that besides physical distance of approximately 108 Kms. between the parental house of the applicant and Hisar, applicant has the responsibility to look after minor girl child aged about 4 years, born out of the wedlock. The criminal proceedings pertaining to FIR No.143 dated 05.06.2016 under Sections 498-A etc. IPC are pending in the Court at Sirsa and the respondent-husband is contesting the case.

Counsel for the respondent has not disputed factual assertions made by the applicant.

In view of the above, taking into consideration convenience of the applicant and the minor child, the aforesaid petition is withdrawn from the Court at Hisar and transferred to the Court of District Judge, Sirsa. The District Judge, Sirsa may keep the petition on its board or assign it to a Court of competent jurisdiction at Sirsa.
