REKHA MITTAL, J. (Oral)

The applicant prays for transfer of petition under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 (in short 'the Act') from Rohtak to Sonipat.

The only inconvenience pleaded by the applicant is that there is distance of approximately 55/60 Kms. between village of the applicant and Rohtak, creating difficulty to defend the proceedings at Rohtak.

Indisputably, physical distance between two places is approximately 55 Kms. Counsel for the applicant, in response to a query, would inform that distance between village of the applicant and Court at Sonipat is approximately 20 Kms. Under the circumstances, it is appropriate that the applicant is allowed to proceed at the place where the same is filed. However, the applicant may file application for issuance of appropriate directions in the light of judgment of Hon'ble the Supreme Court **Krishna Veni Nagam VS. Harish Nagam, 2017(2) RCR (Civil) 358.**

The petition stands disposed of with the aforesaid observations.
