This order will dispose of TA Nos.485 and 511 of 2017 as these have emerged out of proceedings under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 filed by one of the applicants Rose Gupta – husband of Shalu Gupta.

Counsel for the parties are ad idem that the petition pending in the Court of District Judge, Family Court, Hisar may be transferred to a Court of competent jurisdiction at Patiala.

In view of the above and to remove apprehension conceived by the parties, petition under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 Rose Gupta Vs. Shalu Gupta, pending in the Court of District Judge, Family Court, Hisar is withdrawn from the said Court and is transferred to the Court of Additional District Judge, Patiala dealing with the cases under the Hindu Marriage Act. The transferee Court shall put its best efforts to expedite the proceedings.
