Rekha Mittal, J.

The applicant prays for transfer of petition titled “Bhupinder Singh vs. Sandeep Kaur” filed by her husband under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 (in short “the Act”) from the Court of Additional District and Sessions Judge, Amritsar to a Court of competent jurisdiction at Tarn Taran.

The only inconvenience pleaded by the applicant is that distance between village of the applicant from Amritsar is approximately 40 Kms and there is no direct transport facility from her village to Amritsar and she has a child aged about one year to look after.

The distance between the two places is approximately 40 Kms and distance between village of the applicant and Tarn Taran is 14-15 Kms. In the circumstances, it would be appropriate that the petition is allowed to proceed at the place where the same was filed. However, the applicant may file an appropriate application before the Court for issuance of directions in the light of judgment of Hon'ble the Supreme Court of India in **Krishna**

Veni Nagam vs. Harish Nagam 2017(2) RCR(Civil) 358. In case such an application is filed by the applicant, the same shall be disposed of by the court below before proceeding further with the trial.

With the aforesaid observations, the application is disposed of.
