Rekha Mittal, J.

The applicant-wife prays for transfer of petition filed under Section 9 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 (in short “the Act”) titled “Ajay Kumar vs. Sangeeta” from the Court of Civil Judge (Senior Division), Jind to a Court of competent jurisdiction at Hisar.

The only inconvenience pleaded by the applicant is that it would be inconvenient for her to go to the Court at Jind. The distance between the two places is about 80 Kms. It will be appropriate that the case which was filed earlier is allowed to be proceeded where the same is filed. The applicant is at liberty to apply to the Court for maintenance and travelling expense and the Court at Jind would pass an appropriate order providing for maintenance before calling upon the applicant to file reply. The Court shall also ensure that on every hearing when the wife appears, the

husband pays the amount determined as travelling expense for herself and
an escort, before the trial progresses further.

Application for transfer is disposed of but with the aforesaid
observations.
