Rekha Mittal, J.

The applicant-wife has prayed for transfer of petition filed under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 by the respondent-husband pending in the Court of Additional District Judge, Ropar.

The inconvenience pleaded is that she being a deserted lady finds it difficult to defend the proceedings in the Court at Ropar at the cost of incurring expenses of Rs. 1,000/- on each and every date of hearing.

The distance between the place of residence of the applicant and the Court at Ropar is even less than 30 Kms. The applicant is at liberty to apply to the Court for maintenance and travelling expense for every hearing and the Court at Ropar will pass an appropriate order, in accordance with law. However, the Court shall ensure that on every hearing when the wife appears, the husband pays the amount determined as travelling expense for herself and an escort, before the trial progresses further.

With the aforesaid observations, the application is dismissed.
