The applicant prays for transfer of petition titled **Amit Vs. Minakshi** filed under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 (in short 'the Act') by the respondent/husband from the Court of District Judge, Family Court, Hisar to a Court of competent jurisdiction at Panipat.

Counsel for the applicant has submitted that distance between two places is approximately 180 Kms. The applicant has no source of income to maintain herself and is dependent upon her father. She is terrified on account of cruel behavior of the respondent/husband and her in-laws family members. Counsel would inform that pleadings in the petition are yet to be completed.

The respondent caused appearance through counsel but failed to file reply since 03.08.2017. Counsel for the respondent is not present in the Court to say something in the matter.

In view of the above, taking into consideration convenience of the applicant who is living at the mercy of her father, the petition aforesaid

is withdrawn from the Court of District Judge, Family Court, Hisar and transferred to the Court at District Judge, Panipat. The District Judge, Panipat may keep the petition on its own board or assign it to a Court of competent jurisdiction for further proceedings in accordance with law.

The petition stands disposed of accordingly.
