Rekha Mittal, J.

The applicant-wife has filed a petition under Protection of Women from Domestic Violence Act, 2005 in a Court at Ludhiana after the husband has filed a petition for divorce at Hoshiarpur.

The inconvenience pleaded is that in view of physical distance between Ludhiana and Hoshiarpur, it will be inconvenient for her to go to the Court at Hoshiarpur. Another plea raised is that petition filed under Protection of Women from Domestic Violence Act is pending at Ludhiana.

The distance between the two places is approximately 85 Kms. and it will be appropriate that the case which was filed earlier is allowed to be proceeded at the place where it was filed. The applicant is at liberty to file an appropriate application before the Court for maintenance and

travelling expense for herself and an escort for every hearing. In case such an application is filed by the applicant, the same shall be decided by the Court at Hoshiarpur before proceeding further with the trial. The Court shall ensure that on every hearing when the wife appears, the husband pays the amount determined as travelling expense for the applicant and an escort, if any, before the trial progresses.

With the aforesaid observations, application for transfer is dismissed.
