Rekha Mittal, J.

The applicant has prayed for transfer of HMA 280 of 2016 titled "Deepak Singh vs. Rekha Rani" filed by the respondent-husband under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 from the Court of District Judge, Family Court, Pathankot to any Court of competent jurisdiction at Gurdaspur.

The inconvenience pleaded is that distance between village Bogal, Tehsil and District Gurdaspur and Pathankot is more than 45 Kms. and it is extremely difficult for the applicant to attend proceedings at Pathankot.

Admittedly, distance between two places is approximately 45 Kms. and it will be appropriate that the case is allowed to be proceeded where the same is filed. The applicant is at liberty to apply to the Court for maintenance and travelling expense for herself and an escort for every hearing. The Court shall ensure that on every hearing when the wife appears, the husband pays the amount determined as travelling expense for herself and an escort before the trial proceeds further.

The application for transfer is dismissed with the aforesaid observations for compliance by the Court at Pathankot.
