The applicant-wife prays for transfer of HMA 992/2017 titled 'Gaurav Kumar v. Gurwinder Kaur alias Simran' filed under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 by the respondent-husband from the Court of Additional District Judge, Ludhiana to a Court of competent jurisdiction at Jalandhar.

The distance between two places is less than 60 kms., therefore, it would be appropriate if the proceedings are allowed to continue in the Court of Additional District Judge, Ludhiana.

The applicant-wife is at liberty to apply to the Court for maintenance and travelling expenses for every hearing and the Court at Ludhiana will pass an appropriate order, in accordance with law. However, the Court shall ensure that on every hearing when the applicant-wife appears, the husband pays the amount determined as travelling expenses for herself and an escort, before the trial progresses further.

With the aforesaid observations, the application is dismissed.
