Prayer in this application is for transfer of petition under Section 9 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 filed by the respondent-husband titled '*Inderjeet Singh v. Gurwinder Kaur*' from the Court of Additional Civil Judge (Senior Division) Batala, District Gurdaspur to a Court of competent jurisdiction at Jalandhar.

Counsel for the applicant would urge that the applicant is working as Agriculture Sub Inspector at Jalandhar and she has a two years old child to look after, creating inconvenience for the applicant to pursue the litigation filed by the respondent, pending in the Court at Batala.

The physical distance between two places is approximately 100 kms. The personal appearance of the applicant is not required on each and every date of hearing. The petitioner is a working lady and looking after the family. Under the circumstances, it would be appropriate if the petition is allowed to proceed at the place where the same is filed. However, the

applicant may file an appropriate application before the trial Court for issuance of directions in the light of judgment of Hon'ble the Supreme Court of India in ***Krishna Veni Nagam vs. Harish Nagam 2017(2) RCR (Civil) 358***. In case such an application is filed, the same shall be disposed of by the Court below before proceeding further with the trial.

The petition stands disposed of accordingly.
