Mr. Sehrawat has failed to accept that on 19.01.2017, substantial payment has been made to the petitioner. But there are some dues (relating to revision of pay) which are yet not being paid.

Learned Assistant Advocate General, Haryana has fairly stated that in case the petitioner moves a detailed and self-contained representation, the respondent No.2 shall decide the same by passing a speaking order thereon.

In view of the above circumstances, let the petitioner move a detailed and self contained representation to respondent No.2 within a period of one month and respondent No.2 is directed to decide the same within a period of three months, thereafter by passing a speaking order from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order and if any amount is found due, the same be released during the aforesaid period.

However, it is made clear that if any due amount is not released within the aforesaid period, the petitioner would be entitled to get interest @ 12% per annum.
