The petitioners pray for transfer of Civil Suit No. 547/2017 titled 'Mohinder Singh v Karam Singh and others' from the Court of Civil Judge (Junior Division), Ropar to a Court of competent jurisdiction at Phillaur, Jalandhar.

Counsel for the petitioners would contend that a false and frivolous suit has been filed by the respondent/plaintiff, father-in-law of petitioner No. 4 with a sole intent to cause harassment to the petitioners as petitioners No. 1 to 3 have nothing to do with the property, owned by in-laws family of Parminder Kaur-petitioner No. 4.

The fact that a frivolous suit has been filed by the respondent/plaintiff does not constitute a ground for transfer of the proceedings from one place to another place. The physical distance between the two places is approximately 70 kms. Personal appearance of the petitioners is not required on each and every date of hearing.

Without meaning to express any opinion on merits of the case, it is appropriate if the suit is allowed to proceed at the place where the same is filed.

With the aforesaid observations, the petition stands disposed of.
