Prayer in this application is for transfer of petition under Section 9 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 titled 'Gurpreet Singh v Parvinderjit Kaur' filed by the respondent from the Court of Additional Civil Judge (Senior Division) Batala to a Court of competent jurisdiction at Dasuya, District Hoshiarpur.

The only inconvenience pleaded by the applicant is that she is residing with her parents at Dasuya and is working as a teacher in Government Senior Secondary School Village Chak Bamu, Tehsil Dasuya, District Hoshiarpur, at a short distance from the house of her parents.

The physical distance between the two places is approximately 80 kms. The petitioner is a working lady and can afford to attend the proceedings pending in the Court at Batala. Under the circumstances, it is appropriate that the petition is allowed to proceed at the place where the same is filed. However, the applicant may file an application for issuance of

appropriate directions in view of judgment of Hon'ble the Supreme Court of India in ***Krishna Veni Nagam vs. Harish Nagam 2017(2) RCR(Civil) 358.***

In case such an application is filed, the same shall be disposed of by the Court below before proceeding further in the matter.

With the aforesaid observations, the petition stands disposed of.
