Prayer in this application is for transfer of petition titled '*Manjinder Singh v Baljeet Kaur*' filed under Sections 11 and 12 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 by the respondent from the Court of District Judge, Kapurthala to a Court of competent jurisdiction at Amritsar.

Counsel for the applicant would submit that there are two children born out of the previous wedlock of the applicant and she has the responsibility to look after them. The applicant is residing at Beas along with her children but grand parents of children are residing at Amritsar, therefore, the applicant can leave the children with the grand parents as and when she has to appear in the Court at Amritsar.

Indisputably, the applicant is a resident of Beas, District Amritsar. On a query, counsel for the applicant has fairly informed that distance between Beas and Amritsar is approximately 40 kms and so also is the distance between Beas to Kapurthala. The personal appearance of the

applicant is not required on each and every date of hearing. Under the circumstances, it would be appropriate if the petition is allowed to proceed at the place where the same is filed. However, the applicant is at liberty to file an appropriate application before the Court below for grant of maintenance as well as travelling expenses etc. in view of judgment of Hon'ble the Supreme Court of India in ***Krishna Veni Nagam vs. Harish Nagam 2017(2) RCR(Civil) 358***. In case such an application is filed, the same shall be disposed of by the Court below before proceeding further in the matter.

With the aforesaid observations, the petition stands disposed of.
