Heard.

The writ petition i.e. CWP No.11502 of 2016 filed by the applicant-petitioner was dismissed on 20.12.2016 holding that he is not entitled to the promotional increments in terms of the Notification. However, the other petitions were allowed. Learned counsel for the applicant-petitioner claims that the petitioner is also entitled to the promotional increment and wants the review the said order.

I am of the view that the case cannot be reopened on the ground of addressing arguments on merits. If the applicant-petitioner is aggrieved by the said order, he can always approach the higher court. However, there is no error, apparent on the record.

As such, the present review application is dismissed.
