

RA No. CW-15 of 2017 in CWP No. 4229 of 2016

The Arya Bhatt Co-op. Vs. Haryana State Industrial & Infrastructure
Group Housing Society Ltd. Development Corp. Ltd. and others

Present : Mr. Amit Chaudhary, Advocate, for the applicant-petitioner.

Against our order and judgment dated 02.03.2016, the petitioner filed a Petition for Special Leave to Appeal being No. 14579/2016 to the Supreme Court, which was disposed of by the following order dated 30.06.2016 passed by the Supreme Court :-

“Learned senior counsel appearing for the petitioner submits that the High Court has wrongly recorded the facts of the matter in question in dealing with the Writ Petition before it and seeks permission to withdraw the Special Leave Petition with liberty to approach the High Court by placing such facts.

In view thereof, the Special Leave Petition is dismissed as withdrawn with such liberty.”

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the review petitioner states that our order and judgment dated 02.03.2016 did not wrongly record any fact, but there are certain other facts that the petitioner would like to rely upon. The liberty was granted by the Supreme Court only in view of the statement that the facts of the matter were wrongly recorded in our order and judgment dated 02.03.2016. In these circumstances, application for review of our order and judgment dated 02.03.2016 is dismissed.
