Rajesh Bindal, J.

Review of the order dated 9.2.2017 has been sought. The argument raised is that Hon'ble the Supreme Court in Civil Appeal No. 6112 of 2017 arising out of SLP (C) No. 13551 of 2015 Government of NCT of Delhi vs Manav Dharam Trust and others, decided on 4.5.2017, opined that a subsequent purchaser, assignee, successor-in-interest and power of attorney holder can invoke jurisdiction of this Court for lapsing of acquisition proceedings under Section 24(2) of The Right to Fair Compensation and Transparency in Land Acquisition, Rehabilitation and Resettlement Act, 2013. In the case in hand, the writ petition was dismissed on the ground that the petitioners were subsequent buyers.

Considering the aforesaid judgment, in our view, the Review Application deserves to be allowed. Ordered accordingly.

The writ petition is restored to its original number.
