KARNAIL SINGH V/S STATE OF PUNJAB

This Court had made an order on March 22, 2017 directing the concerned police station officer to file an affidavit as to why the car Mahindra Xylo was kept in police station.

In compliance of that order, affidavit of Shri Vijay Kumar, Inspector, Station House Officer, Police Station Sadar Dhuri, District Sangrur has been filed today and the following statements have been made therein:-

“With regard to Xylo Car mentioned at Serial No.3 is concerned, same was given to its owner Daya Chand s/o Raghbir Singh r/o H.No.189, Great Noida vide DDR No.19 dated 7.6.2013 in the light of order passed by Ld.S.D.J.M., Dhuri, however, the order of releasing the said vehicle to said Daya Chand was later on cancelled by the Court of Ld. Addl. Sessions Judge, Sangrur for which DDR No.33 dated 30.07.2015 was recorded in the Roznamcha of P.S. Sadar Dhuri and the vehicle was kept in the Police Station. Now, above said Daya Chand has again filed application for releasing this vehicle to him before the Court of Ld. Addl. Sessions Judge, Sangrur, which is pending for 11.5.2017.”

In terms of the above statements, no further orders are necessary, since the Sessions Court would consider the request for handing over the car Mahindra Xylo.
