Applicants/respondents have filed this review application after dismissal of Special Leave to Appeal (Civil No.29460 of 2017) by the Hon'ble Supreme Court. It is correct that summary dismissal of the SLP at admission stage does not bar filing of the review application.

Hence, I have proceeded to hear a new Senior counsel for the applicants/respondents, who has vehemently argued that this Court has not considered the revenue record/jamabandi for the year 1954-55, while

deciding the case.

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A reading of the judgment would show that this Court considered the entire revenue record right from 1951-52 and after considering the entire aspects of the matter, the case was decided and the judgment sought to be review was passed.

In view thereof, there is no scope for interference.

Hence, this review application is dismissed.
