

**RA-CW-387-2017 in
CWP No.11720 of 2017**

PUNJAB STATE POWER CORPORATION LIMITED AND ORS

The instant application has been filed under Section 115 read with order 47 Rule 1 CPC and Article 226 of the Constitution of India seeking review of order dated 18.07.2017 passed by this Court while disposing of the Civil Writ Petition No.11720 of 2017.

Suffice it to notice that the applicant who was serving as Revenue Accountant with Punjab State Power Corporation Limited had filed the writ petition seeking direction to the respondent-Corporation to release in his favour the training incentive/honorarium under the National Training Policy for the Power Sector adopted by the Corporation in the year 2007 in lieu of the petitioner having trained other employees towards an induction module and other departmental trainings for the period 2005 to 2016.

The writ petition was disposed of on 18.07.2017 relegating the applicant/petitioner to avail of his civil remedy, if so advised.

Present application has been filed for review of the order dated 18.07.2017 on the basis that material information was not available at the time the writ petition was disposed of and now relevant material has been placed on record and appended along with the review application.

Having heard counsel for the applicant at length, this Court is of the considered view that the instant review application is misdirected.

There is not even a word in the application that review is sought on the basis of certain documents which in spite of exercise of due diligence were not in the knowledge of the applicant at the stage of filing of the writ petition.

If the prayer of the applicant for review/recalling of the order dated 18.07.2017 is accepted in terms of the averments made in the application, there would never be any finality to the proceedings. Applicant in the garb of the instant review application is seeking a rehearing of the matter.

No ground for review is made out.

Application stands dismissed.
