This application seeks review/recall of the order dated 11.11.2016. Two sets of writ petition were filed one by Balwinder Singh and Kuldip Kaur, respectively claiming themselves to be owners of the land acquired by NHAI. It was further averred that compensation amount though lying deposited with the Land Acquisition Collector, was not being released to them. The writ petition was disposed of without going into the merits with a direction to the Land Acquisition Collector to verify the records and release the amount if had not been already paid.

The review applicants have averred that the title dispute between them is pending consideration before the Civil Court.

If that is so, they will be at liberty to approach the Land Acquisition Collector-cum-SDM, Kotkapura to show that there is a title dispute pending between

the parties before the Civil Court. In that event, the Land Acquisition Collector shall be at liberty to keep the compensation amount in FDR so as to fetch maximum interest till such time the title dispute is decided and compensation amount is disbursed to the true owner(s).
