SUBHASH CHANDER VS STATE OF PUNJAB AND ANOTHER

Present: Applicant in person.

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The instant review application has been filed seeking recall/review of the order dated September 03, 2015.

We have heard the review applicant in person, on merits. The applicant submits that the plot in dispute is still lying unallotted, hence the cancellation letter dated 28.10.1991 may be set aside. We are, however, not impressed by the submission. Admittedly, the allotment of the plot was cancelled way back on 28.10.1991. The review-applicant-petitioner chose to challenge that order by way of a writ petition filed in the year 2015 which we dismissed primarily on the ground of delay and laches. In the order dated September 03, 2015 this Court further explained that repeated representations/ service of legal notice will not revive the cause of action. Similarly, the fact that the plot is still lying unallotted does not give rise to a fresh cause of action.

No case to review/recall the order dated September 03, 2015 is made out.

Dismissed.

Since the review application has been dismissed on merit, no separate order is required to be passed on the application for condonation of delay of 465 days in filing the review application.
