Balbir Singh and Jasveer Kaur, parents of deceased Gurdarshan Singh have filed this application for review of order dated October 6, 2016, passed by this Court in CWP-21005-2016. They claim that they are entitled to the entire retiral benefits of deceased Gurdarshan Singh and claim that Paramjit Kaur (non applicant-petitioner) is not wife of Gurdarshan Singh. All these pensionary benefits are payable to them only.

The perusal of order dated October 6, 2016, passed in CWP-21005-2016, shows that merely a direction was issued to respondents to process the case of the petitioner on priority basis. It was never directed that

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all the pensionary benefits be released to the petitioner exclusively. The benefits are to be released in accordance with law. If the applicants have got any case, they can always make a representation to the concerned department and if their claim is denied, they can always file a civil suit, claiming exclusive rights of pensionary benefits of deceased employee.

In view of the above, review application is disposed of.
