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Simranjit Singh and anr. Vs. PSPCL and others

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The applicant was respondent No.3 in CWP No. 12409 of 2017 filed by Simaranjit Singh and another seeking release of electric motor connection.

The petition filed by above said petitioners was disposed of with a direction to the Director, Punjab State Power Corporation Limited to consider the claim of the non-applicant/ petitioners within a period of two months after the receipt of a certified copy of the order.

It is averred in the application that the non-applicant/ petitioners had earlier filed a suit which was dismissed and by concealing the facts, the non-applicant/ petitioners had filed the petition.

In the light of above circumstances, the review of the order dated May 31, 2017 has been prayed for on the ground that there is likelihood of non-applicant/ petitioners to get a favourable order on consideration of representation.

After hearing counsel for the applicant, I am of the considered opinion that the applicant, no doubt, was impleaded as respondent No.3 in the writ petition but so far as the determination of right of applicant-respondent No.3 is concerned, the applicant cannot seek review of the order as no prejudicial order has been passed by this Court against the applicant.

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The facts lead by the applicant do not warrant review of the order dated May 31, 2017.

Review application is dismissed without prejudice to the rights of the applicant to avail any legal remedy available to him to enforce his rights, if any.
