**SI Balbir Singh and others v. State of Haryana and others**

for the applicants/petitioners.

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This is an application for review of the order dated  
28.07.2017.

We had observed in the said order that the petitioners have not been issued a show cause notice and there is no order adverse to them. They were thus at liberty to raise all the pleas before the competent authority and approach the court in the event of there being any adverse order withdrawing the benefits granted to them.

This review application has been made on the ground that a show cause notice had been issued to the petitioners. If that is so, even then this would be no ground for them for review of the order dated 28.07.2017 considering that the underlying import of the said order was that in the absence of any adverse order we would decline interference, particularly when the petitioners have liberty to appear before the competent authority to raise all the pleas before him. Considering that at that point of time it was projected that no show cause notice had been issued and assuming that it stood issued, there would still be no reason to review our order which had taken care of the interest of the

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petitioners who would have been granted liberty to raise all the pleas before the competent authority.

The review application is frivolous and is dismissed with costs of Rs.10,000/- which shall be deposited with the High Court Employees' Welfare Association within one month.
