Review of the order passed by this Court on 3.4.2017 has been sought by the State.

Learned counsel for the applicant submitted that on 3.4.2017, a bunch of 412 petitions pertaining to different acquisitions was listed, out of which in some of the cases, statement was made that no award had been passed as administrative approval was not granted by the State. Those cases were disposed of as the acquisition proceedings were lapsed. Inadvertently that statement was made in the present petition as well, whereas for the acquisition in question, award was announced by the Collector on 27.12.2016. The prayer is for recalling the order dated 3.4.2017 and hearing the writ petition on merits.

Notice in the applications to counsel opposite.

Mr. Sushil K. Sharma, Advocate, who is present in Court, accepts the same.

Heard learned counsel for the parties and perused the paper book.

Delay in filing the Review Application is condoned.

As the fact that award was announced for the acquisition in question, is not disputed, in our view, the order dated 3.4.2017, disposing the writ petition by noticing the statement made by learned counsel for the State that award had not been announced, deserves to be recalled. Ordered accordingly.

The Review Application stands disposed of.

The main petition is restored to its original number. The same is taken on Board and is disposed of by a separate order of even date.
