RAMESHWAR SINGH MALIK, J. (ORAL)

Against the order dated 02.03.2016, whereby a bunch of seven civil revision petitions were allowed by this Court, judgment-debtors approached the Hon'ble Supreme Court and the Hon'ble Supreme Court passed the following order on 20.02.2017:-

“We find no ground to interfere with the impugned order. However, learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner seeks leave to withdraw these petitions with permission to file review before the High Court. Permission granted. Consequently the Special Leave petitions are dismissed as withdrawn with the aforesaid liberty.”

As a consequence of the abovesaid order passed by the Hon'ble Supreme Court, the present review application has been filed.

After hearing the learned counsel for the applicant and keeping in view the totality of facts and circumstances of the case, since no case for review is made out, application for condonation of delay of 420 days in filing the review application is also liable to be dismissed.

In view of the above, both these applications are dismissed.
