

128 Review Application no.407 of 2017 in CWP no.17070 of 2017

Priyanka Jagga v. State of Haryana and others

Present: Mr. Lajpat Sharma, Advocate, for the applicant-petitioner.

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By this application, the petitioner seeks a review of the order dated 11.08.2017, by which the petition was dismissed with liberty to the petitioner to avail of her remedy before the Industrial Tribunal/Labour Court.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the order be modified to the extent that the petitioner be directed to be considered for employment by a new contractor, if any is appointed by the Municipal Committee, Rajound.

Obviously, the petitioner cannot be debarred for applying for any job afresh, whether with a different contractor or directly to the Municipal Committee etc; but as regards creating a right in the petitioner to do so, is something which this Court is not going into, as already stated in the order dated 11.08.2017, by which liberty was given to the petitioner to avail of her remedy before the Industrial Tribunal, as already stated.

Consequently, with the aforesaid observations reiterated, this application is dismissed.
