This application has been moved for review of order dated 8.5.2017.

Learned counsel for the applicant contends that vide order dated 8.5.2017, liberty was given to the applicant-appellant to move an application before the lower appellate Court for amendment in the title of judgment and decree but the appeal has been dismissed. He further contends that the word '*dismissal*' may come in the way of the applicant-appellant in case he approaches the lower appellate Court.

Heard arguments of learned counsel for the applicant-appellant.

Vide order dated 8.5.2017, liberty was given to the applicant-appellant to move an application before the lower appellate Court for amendment in the title of judgment and decree. In case the applicant-appellant is aggrieved in any manner, he is at liberty to approach against the said order as appeal was dismissed being not maintainable and as such order of dismissal will not be dismissal on merit.

Application is disposed of accordingly.
