Bachittar Singh and others versus State of Punjab and another

A perusal of order dated 11.12.2017 reveals that the present petition was accepted and FIR No.52 was ordered to be quashed qua the petitioners subject to depositing costs of Rs.10,000/- by them with the Punjab Legal Services Authority, Chandigarh, within one week, failing which it was ordered that the petition shall be deemed to have been dismissed and the case was ordered to be listed on 18.12.2017 for production of receipt regarding deposit of costs.

Office report indicates that cost of Rs.10,000/- has not been received. Faced with this situation, this court has no option, but to dismiss the instant petition for not depositing costs of Rs.10,000/-. Accordingly, this petition is dismissed. FIR stands revived. The State of Punjab would proceed with the FIR, in accordance with law. Intimation with respect to revival of the aforesaid FIR registered under sections 323, 452, 506, 148 and 149 IPC against the petitioners be sent to the Senior Superintendent of Police, District Gurdaspur and proceed with the matter as per law.
