The only ground for reviewing the order dated 02.08.2013 is that the subsequent promotion order dated 04.09.2017 has been made to detriment of the petitioner. Once that is so, the petitioner has a fresh cause of action to challenge the said order, which was never part of the writ petition, which was filed in the year 2013. On account of promotion order which was subject matter of challenge in the present writ petition having been withdrawn, the writ petition was dismissed.

Resultantly, there is no ground made out to review the order dated 02.08.2017 and also to condone the delay of 84 days in filing the review application or take additional documents on record.
