Applicant seeks condonation of delay of 409 days in filing the review application and also seeks review of the order dated 03.03.2016 passed by this Court.

After hearing the learned counsel for the applicant, no ground for interference has been made out in either of these two applications. There is hardly any explanation given for condonation of delay of 409 days in filing the review application. It is also a matter of record that the Hon'ble Supreme Court has dismissed the SLP filed by the applicant and thus, the order dated 03.03.2016 passed by this Court has attained finality. Neither any permission was sought nor any such permission was granted by the Hon'ble Supreme Court to the applicant for filing the present review application. Under the garb

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of instant review application, applicant seeks to re-argue the appeal, which is not permissible in law. In this view of the matter, neither any ground of condonation of unexplained and long delay of 409 days in filing the review application nor any ground for interference in the review application has been made out.
