Exemption allowed subject to all just exceptions.

The application stands disposed of.

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1. Present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of FIR No.414/2015 registered under Sections 498A/406/34 IPC at PS Nangloi. It is stated that the matter has been settled amicably with the complainant / respondent No.2 before the Counselling Cell, Family Courts (North-West), Rohini, Delhi vide settlement agreement dated 03.03.2016.

2. Complainant / respondent No.2 is present with her father and

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counsel and has been identified by him. I have enquired from the complainant if she has settled the dispute with the petitioners amicably without any fear or pressure. She has informed that all the disputes between the parties have been resolved amicably with her free consent and she has no objection to the quashing of the FIR in question. Divorce by mutual consent has already been granted. Pursuant to the settlement, remaining amount of ₹20,000/- by way of demand draft bearing No.817894 dated 07.01.2017 drawn on Punjab National Bank has been given to the complainant in the Court today.

3. The petition is supported by affidavits of the parties. Copy of settlement agreement dated 03.03.2016 has been placed on record. Since the dispute between the parties has been settled, no useful purpose will be served to continue with the proceedings. In the interest of justice and to enable the parties to settle in life after divorce, FIR No.414/2015 registered under Sections 498A/406/34 IPC at PS Nangloi and all the proceedings arising therefrom are quashed.

4. The petition stands disposed of accordingly.
