**ORDER
01.02.2017**

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(1) Present petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. has been preferred by the petitioner for quashing of FIR No.165/2015 under Section 354/506 IPC registered at Police Station Pahar Ganj. It is stated that the matter has been settled with the complainant/respondent No.2 amicably before Mediation Centre, Tis Hazari Courts. Order sheet dated 24.09.2016 also records the intention of the parties to settle the dispute.

(2) Respondent No.2-complainant is present before the Court along with her mother. The Investigating Officer has identified her. I have enquired from the complainant whether the matter has been settled with the petitioner amicably without fear and pressure. She has informed that the matter has been settled without any fear or pressure and she has no objection to the quashing of the FIR.

(3) The petition is supported by the affidavits of the parties. Settlement/Compromise deed dated 18.12.2015 signed by the parties before Mediation Centre, Tis Hazari Courts is on record. It is informed that cross-case has since been compounded between the parties.

(4) Since the complainant/Respondent No.2 has voluntarily settled the dispute with the petitioner, no useful purpose will be served to continue with the proceedings. In the interest of justice and to put an end to the litigation, FIR No.165/2015 under Section 354/506 IPC registered at Police Station Pahar Ganj and all the proceedings emanating therefrom are quashed.

(5) The petitioner is, however, burdened with costs of ₹10,000/- to be deposited with Prime Minister Relief Fund within two weeks. The Registry shall ensure the compliance of the order.

(6) The petition and all pending application(s) stand disposed of accordingly.
