The present petition has been filed by the petitioner who is the wife of the deceased employee with the following prayers:

“In the circumstances, it is most respectfully prayed that this Hon’ble Court may be pleased to: -

- (i) Issue a writ of mandamus or any other appropriate writ to direct the respondent to release the pension or retirement benefits accruable the petitioner along with an interest @18% p.a.;*
- (ii) Direct the respondent to pay damages for mental agony, harassment, torture or humiliation to the tune of Rs.2,00,000/- to the petitioner;*
- (iii) Award cost of the petition in favour of the petitioner.*
- (iv) Pass such further or other orders which may be deemed just and proper in the circumstances of the case”*

After some submissions, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks to withdraw the petition, to approach the respondents with a representation.

Noting the aforesaid submission, the petition is dismissed as withdrawn.
