**ORDER**

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By the present petition the petitioners seek quashing of FIR No. 42/2011 under Sections 379/411/420/467/468/471/120B/34 IPC registered at PS Chhawala, Delhi on the complaint of Respondent No.2 and the proceedings pursuant thereto on the ground that the parties have settled the matter.

Learned APP for the State on instructions from Investigating Officer submits that in the above-noted FIR the two petitioners are only facing trial for the reason Raghubir who was kept in column No.11 has since passed away whereas Sonu the fourth accused in the FIR was kept in column No.12 and never summoned. She states that the respondent No.2 is the only complainant/ victim.

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Respondent No. 2 is present in Court and is identified by the Investigating Officer. He states that he has settled the matter with the petitioners and does not wish to pursue the above-noted FIR and the proceedings pursuant thereto.

Petitioners who are present in Court and are identified by the learned counsel affirm the statement of respondent No.2.

In view of the fact that the parties have amicably resolved their differences of their own free will, volition and without any coercion and no useful purpose will be served in continuance of the proceedings, rather the same would create further acrimony between them, it would be in the interest of justice to quash the abovementioned FIR and the proceedings pursuant thereto. There is no legal impediment in quashing the FIR in question.

Consequently, FIR No. 42/2011 under Sections 379/411/420/467/468/471/120B/34 IPC registered at PS Chhawala, Delhi and proceedings pursuant thereto are hereby quashed.

Parties have signed this order sheet in acknowledgment of their statements made before this Court.

Petition is disposed of. Order dasti.
