1. Present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of FIR No.482/2014 registered under Sections 498A/406/34 IPC at PS Sangam Vihar. It is stated that the matter has been settled amicably with the complainant / respondent No.2 before the Mediation Centre, Saket Courts, New Delhi vide settlement agreement dated 10.08.2016.

2. Complainant / respondent No.2 is present with counsel and has been identified by the Investigating Officer. I have enquired from the complainant if she has settled the dispute with the petitioners

Since the dispute between the parties has been settled, no useful purpose will be served to continue with the proceedings. In the interest of justice and to enable the parties to put an end to the litigation, FIR No.482/2014 registered under Sections 498A/406/34 IPC at PS Sangam Vihar and all the proceedings arising therefrom are quashed.

4. The petition stands disposed of accordingly.
