1. In view of the judgment of the Supreme Court in the case of *Shashi Gaur Vs. NCT of Delhi, (2001) 10 SCC 445* which holds that an action of termination of an employee of a school has necessarily to

be challenged by filing of an appeal before the Delhi School Tribunal under Section 8 (3) of the Delhi School Education Act, 1973, accordingly, at request, these writ petitions are taken as appeals filed before the Delhi School Tribunal with the date of filing of the appeals before the Delhi School Tribunal being the date on which the writ petitions were filed in this Court and these writ petitions are therefore transferred for decision as appeals before the Delhi School Tribunal under Section 8 (3) of the Delhi School Education Act.
