Present contempt petition has been filed alleging wilful disobedience of the order dated 31st May, 2016, passed by a Coordinate Bench of this Court in W.P.(C) No.4881/2016 whereby paragraphs 14 (xxviii) and 16 (xii) of the respondents' 'Revised Policy for grant of License to the Meat Shops' requiring submission of a No Objection Certificate from the Area Councillor for grant/renewal of license for meat shops were quashed/struck down.

Learned counsel for the petitioners states that despite the aforesaid

order, respondents have issued letters dated 23rd June, 2016 and 01st February, 2017 directing the petitioners to submit a No Objection Certificate from the concerned Municipal Councillor.
