These three criminal writ petitions invoke Articles 226 and 227 of the Constitution of India read with Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 (Cr.P.C.) to bring challenge to the order dated 06.01.2010

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of the court of Special Judge (Prevention of Corruption Act) on the file of criminal case no.84/2008 on the basis of report under Section 173 Cr.P.C. submitted by the Central Bureau of Investigation (CBI) upon conclusion of the investigation into RC 3(A)/2005/CBI-ACU-IX, New Delhi wherein the petitioners stood arraigned as accused persons. By the impugned order, the learned Special Judge dismissed the application of the accused seeking further investigation under Section 173(8) Cr.P.C. also invoking Section 207 Cr.P.C.

It is noted that the petitioners have not shown any interest in these proceedings since 2014.

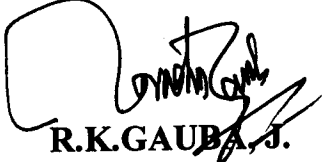
