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Present writ petition has been filed seeking a direction to the respondent to refund the security fee deposited by the petitioner in terms of the Awards of the contracts for operation and management of on-board catering service in Train Nos. 2801-02, 5089-90/2589-90, 2507-08/09-10, 2505-06, 5929-30, 5609-10, 2311-12, 2859-60, 8033-34/2833-34, 2779-80, 2909-10, 2903-04 amounting to Rs.1,66,89,000.
