Be that as it may, in case, salary for the month of March, 2017 has not been paid, the same would be released to the petitioner within a period of one month from today. In case, the petitioner requires to complete the formalities and/or to sign the papers, the same would be communicated to the petitioner within 15 days.

It is clarified that the Court has not commented on merits of the contentions of the petitioner with regard to the posting or any contention raised by the respondents.

The writ petition is disposed of in the aforesaid terms.
