Srinivasa Reddy vs. Karnataka Urban Water Supply and Drainage Board Employees' Association and Ors. (2006) 11SCC 731* and *Rajesh Awasthi vs. Nand Lal Jaiswal and Ors. (2013)1 SCC 501*, and therefore, this writ petition is prayed to be withdrawn with liberty to the petitioner to file appropriate independent proceedings to seek the relief of declaration.

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2. The writ petition is accordingly allowed to be withdrawn with the aforesaid liberty to file independent proceedings, of course in accordance with law.
