By the present petition the petitioners seek quashing of FIR No. 120/2013 under Sections 354A/323/325 IPC registered at PS Moti Nagar, Delhi on the complaint of Respondent No.2 and the proceedings pursuant thereto on the ground that the parties have settled the matter.

Learned APP for the State on instructions from Investigating Officer submits that in the above-noted FIR the five petitioners are the only accused, respondent No.2 the complainant/ victim and respondent No.3 the other victim.

Respondent No. 2 & 3 are present in Court and are identified by the learned counsel. They state that they have settled the matter with the

petitioners before the mediation centre, CAW Cell, Govt. of NCT Delhi on 5th May, 2014 and in view thereof they do not wish to pursue the above-noted FIR and the proceedings pursuant thereto.

The petitioners who are present in Court and are identified by the counsel affirm the statement of respondent No.2 and 3 and state that they will abide by the terms of settlement arrived at between the parties.

In view of the fact that the parties have amicably resolved their differences of their own free will, volition and without any coercion and no useful purpose will be served in continuance of the proceedings, rather the same would create further acrimony between them, it would be in the interest of justice to quash the abovementioned FIR and the proceedings pursuant thereto. There is no legal impediment in quashing the FIR in question.

Consequently, FIR No. 120/2013 under Sections 354A/323/325 IPC registered at PS Moti Nagar, Delhi and proceedings pursuant thereto are hereby quashed.

Parties have signed this order sheet in acknowledgment of their statements made before this Court.

The petition is disposed of. Order dasti.
