This Court notes that this petition has been disposed of on 18.7.2016 by a speaking order. This order was passed in the presence of the petitioner. The petitioner has thereafter moved an application which had not been prosecuted by the petitioner. The Court was constrained to dismiss that application in default as also for non-prosecution. This was on 28.11.2015. On the said date counsel for the petitioner/applicant had put in appearance. He had sought a recall of the order.
