ORDER

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15.02.2017

(1) Present petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. has been preferred by the petitioner for quashing of FIR No.343/15 under Section 135 of Indian Electricity Act and Section 379 IPC registered at Police Station Jamia Nagar. It is stated that the matter has been settled with the complainant/respondent No.2 amicably.

(2) Learned counsel for respondent No.2/BSES is present before the Court. I have enquired from him whether the matter has been settled with the petitioner amicably. He has informed that the matter has been settled and all agreed dues have been paid and he has no

objection to the quashing of the FIR.

(3) The petition is supported by the affidavits of the parties.

(4) Since the complainant/Respondent No.2 has voluntarily settled the dispute with the petitioner and he has paid the dues, no useful purpose will be served to continue with the proceedings. In the interest of justice and to put an end to the litigation, FIR No.343/15 under Section 135 of Indian Electricity Act and Section 379 IPC registered at Police Station Jamia Nagar and all the proceedings emanating therefrom are quashed.

(5) The petitioner is, however, burdened with costs of ₹15,000/- to be deposited with Prime Minister National Relief Fund within two weeks. The Registry shall ensure the compliance of the order.

(6) The petition stands disposed of accordingly.
