CRL.M.C. 1392/2017 & CRL.M.A.No.5682/2017 (Stay)

1. Present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of FIR No.639/2015 registered under Sections 498A/406/34 IPC at PS Subhash Place. It is stated that the matter has been settled amicably with the complainant / respondent No.2 before the Mediation Centre, Rohini Courts, Delhi vide settlement agreement dated 26.02.2016.

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2. Complainant / respondent No.2 is present with counsel and has been identified by the Investigating Officer. I have enquired from the complainant if she has settled the dispute with the petitioner amicably without any fear or pressure. She has informed that the dispute with the petitioner has been resolved amicably with her free consent and she has no objection to the quashing of the FIR in question. Divorce by mutual consent has already been granted. Pursuant to the settlement, remaining amount of ₹6.5 lacs [₹6 lacs by way of demand draft bearing No.036847 dated 10.04.2017 drawn on HDFC Bank and ₹50,000/- (in cash)] has been paid to her today by the petitioner. Statement to that effect has been recorded separately.

3. The petition is supported by affidavits of the parties. Copy of settlement agreement dated 26.02.2016 has been placed on record. Since the dispute with the petitioner has been settled, no useful purpose will be served to continue with the proceedings against him. In the interest of justice and to enable the parties to settle in life after divorcee, FIR No.639/2015 registered under Sections 498A/406/34 IPC at PS Subhash Place and all the proceedings arising therefrom are quashed qua the petitioner.

4. The petition stands disposed of accordingly. Pending application also stands disposed of.
