Learned counsel for the parties submit that the Arbitral Tribunal has been constituted by the parties comprising of Mr.Justice T.S.Thakur (Retired), Mr.Justice A.K.Patnaik (Retired) and; Mr.Pramod Kumar, Retired (Railways). The Arbitral Tribunal has also held its first sitting on 28.7.2017. It is agreed by the parties that the present petition under section 9 of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996 be converted into a petition under section 17. Learned counsel for the petitioner agrees that the petitioner will file a fresh petition before the learned Arbitral Tribunal under section 17 of the Act.
